APPAREL

Apparel may be viewed online via the personalized team links previously distributed. Apparel will be available for advance purchase from July 1 to July 10. Due to continued supply chain disruption each club will have a personal store and we strongly encourage all purchases via the links. Limited merchandise will be available during the event. All pre-purchased items will be available for pick up July 26th-28th during team practices and throughout the meet.

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Accessible parking will be available with permit only. Please request Accessible parking at BACFinals22@gmail.com and you will be directed to the designated area.

CONCESSIONS

Food and beverage services will be provided on the BAC grounds adjacent to the pool area using Scrip dollars only. An athlete food station will be available near the swimmers' tent. The dining room will be available for indoor seating, but food will be available for purchase outside only.

FIRST AID

First Aid station will be located on Tennis Court # 4 next to the awards area. It will be staffed throughout the weekend to provide medical services and first aid as required for athletes and spectators.

GENERAL ADMISSION PARKING

General Admission Parking will be available off-site only. Guests will be shuttled from the lots to the BAC. We ask for your understanding and cooperation with the parking due to the limited availability onsite and in the surrounding area. To allow for the best experience for all spectators we ask that you follow the designated parking areas.

No swim meet parking is allowed on neighborhood streets or at surrounding businesses. Any cars parked outside of the designated MICSA lots will be towed.

VIP PARKING

VIP parking onsite is limited to patrons who purchased VIP tickets for any or all days, 2 spots provided to each club for coaches and/or swim chairs, officials and the MICSA board.

PURCHASES

Admission and apparel may be purchased with Visa or Mastercard only. All other onsite purchases will require Scrip. Scrip may be purchased with Credit only (MC & VISA). Chitting will not be available for anyone including BAC members.

SWIMMER DROP OFF

Please enter via our driveway just past the main entrance if coming from Lahser Road and just before the main entrance coming from Telegraph Road. Please proceed to the designated drop off area and proceed out the main entrance to the designated parking areas. Attendants will be onsite to provide direction.

2022 MICSA SCORING SUMMARY

The number of swimmers entered determines the number of heats in each preliminary event. The rules specify that there should be a minimum of 3 swimmers in a heat. The last three heats consist of the top 18 swimmers entered in the event. The last three heats are then “circle seeded”, with the fastest swimmers in the inside lanes. Fastest to slowest in each of the last 3 heats would be in lanes 3-4-2-5-1-6 respectively.

The top 12 qualifiers compete on Sunday in the Finals and are eligible to score points for their respective clubs. Qualifiers 7-12 compete in the consolation finals and qualifiers 1-6 compete in the championship finals. Note: No swimmer can place any higher or lower than their group of 6 at finals, regardless of how fast or slow their time is during the Finals on Sunday. For example, the 6th fastest qualifier in the championship heat cannot finish lower than the 6th place.

Qualifiers 13 and 14 are listed as alternates in the event, one or more qualifiers are unable to compete on Sunday at the Finals. Finals events on Sunday will run in Event # sequence from 1-64. This is the same order as the Dual meet events.

Rules:

The current National Federation of State High School Association Rules will govern the 2022 MICSA Finals.

Any exceptions to these rules are listed in the MICSA by-laws.

2022 MICSA FINALS OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

1. Current NFHS Rules apply with the following expectations:

- Backstroke Flags are local pool locations.
- Jewelry is acceptable unless deemed dangerous.
- Logo rule is waived.
- Swimmers will not be eligible to set individual records for any swim on the lead leg of any 100-relay event.
- Swimwear: No Technical Suit [as defined by USA Swimming] shall be worn by any swimmer competing in the MICSA 12 & under age groups.

2. Cones on each side of the pool will identify the 15-meter mark from both ends of the pool.

3. Towels are allowed on the blocks but must not hang over the front edge. Timers will be asked to remove the towel immediately after start of the race.
4. Make sure all swimmers are set at the start! Some may come down before moving into track start position or leaning back.
5. Coaches contact with swimmers:
 - One coach from each team will be allowed by the starting block and turn end of the pool during the 8 & under relays. The coach may not make physical contact with the swimmer.
 - During all other events, no coach is allowed by any starting block. Coaches will be advised on Friday where they can stand during the meet.
 - During individual events, one coach from each team is allowed to talk to their swimmer(s) while they are in marshalling just prior to approaching the starting block for an event.
6. Any coach, participant or guest who displays conduct unbecoming to the spirit of MICSA will be immediately removed from the pool area and asked to leave the club grounds for the remainder of the meet.
7. A meet committee will be established on Friday to resolve disputes relating to swimming matters during the finals.
8. Non-verbal dual confirmation will be required on false start and relay exchange false starts. Write down lane number and, for relays, swimmer number on event sheet and meet in middle to

confer.

9. Dual confirmation is not required on stroke or turn violations. Record all disqualifications on 'disqualification sheet' provided and be sure it gets to the scoring table. Two-way radios will be used for official's communication during the meet! Make every effort to advise swimmer or coach of disqualification!
10. The officials along Lane 1 will be responsible for calling all finishes for all events. The turn judge along Lane 1 will call finishes for the 25-meter events.
11. One touchpad, three semiautomatic buttons and 2 manual dolphin watches will be used for timing finishes.
12. Note for Marshalling: Keep next swimmer away from starting block until a race has been finished and the prior swimmer has left the starting area! During relays, swimmers must stay back from the block area until it is their turn to swim. After a relay member has finished, they should step back away from the block area until the race is done.

A reminder that this year's meet entries must be submitted no later than noon on Sunday, July 24th, 2022. Entries should be sent to:

Entries must be submitted via Team Manager using the championship order of events (64 events). Each club is limited to 84 individual swim entries and 1 relay in each event. Once entered, you will receive an electronic confirmation (PDF) from Mary Beth Leonard by 5pm Sunday for your review to ensure all your entries are correct. Any changes must be made by 8:00 pm Sunday night. No changes will be accepted on

Monday. Please bring your signed entry and payment to the front desk of the Birmingham Athletic Club by 1 p.m. on Monday July 25th.

Please bring the following to the BAC by 1 p.m. on Monday, July 25th:

- Club flag and pole
- MICSA trophies your club may have won last year
- Entry summary sheet - p19 of the meet packet
- Signed hard copy of your team's entries Entry Fee (Check payable to MICSA)
- Individual entries \$7, Relay entries \$28
- Relay entries (remember you may change personnel at the meet up to the announced deadline)
- Team information sheet for opening ceremonies – p20 of the meet packet
- A list of team members with hard to pronounce names for the announcer if not previously submitted.

Note to Swim Chairs and Swim Coaches:

Each team is required to always have at least 1 coach in the swimmers' tent throughout the meet. The teams will be spread across 3 tented tennis courts and monitored by volunteers, but it is the responsibility of the respective clubs to ensure everything is in order with your swimmers and all assigned areas are cleaned at the conclusion of each day.
